### Pastor's Ponderings . . .

Merry Christmas! It is not over yet. There are twelve days of Christmas – they come after Christmas, not before as is sometimes thought by non-liturgical persons. On January 6<sup>th</sup> we then celebrate Epiphany. The Epiphany season is when we remember the coming of the Magi. It is the season when we remember that Jesus came for all people, everywhere.

I have heard of people already taking down their Christmas trees and other decorations. Mine won't come down for a while yet. I have just begun celebrating Christmas.

I used to go shopping on December 26<sup>th</sup>. Because my family does not celebrate until after Christmas Day, I could finish my shopping after December 25th. I used to anticipate long lines of returns and many shoppers out and about. Instead, I often found the stores rather quiet. It reminded of how empty many churches will be this coming Sunday.

We flock to church on Christmas Eve or to the Julotta service on Christmas morning searching for the peace of Christmas. Or maybe we go to be with family. Sometimes it is just what we have always done. As I stood watching people return gifts in the absence of the hub-bub of the last-minute Christmas frenzy I wondered if we do not return Jesus to the shelf as though we are putting away the nativity set when Christmas Day is over.

I wondered if we do not return ourselves to the ordinary when the extraordinary gift of Christmas is given all year long. I should restate that – the gift of Christmas is for infinity – it is for all eternity, not just a few days of the year. Jesus came in order to give salvation to a fallen world. That gift is the gift that continually keeps on giving – year after year – decade after decade – century after century – until at last Christ will return and ultimate peace comes at last.

We search for the perfect gift. We order it and sometimes it doesn't arrive as anticipated. I understand that we want what we want when we want it. Christmas is about more than those undelivered gifts. Christmas is about being with family, about being with those we love. I do agree being with family is wonderful on each and every holiday. Is it possible that is why we come to church on Christmas Eve to be with other Christians – our adopted family in Christ?

Unfortunately, those sentiments don't quite get it for me either. Christmas is about remembering the birth of our Lord and Savior, Jesus the Christ. Christmas is about the gift that God gave humanity in coming to earth so that we might have salvation. Christmas is about God with us in Emmanuel. Christmas is knowing and understanding that Jesus of Nazareth, formerly of Bethlehem came so that we might know God's love for us.

I do not know how you feel about re-gifting or returning gifts. I remember the excitement of Christmas morning watching my children open presents. The worst thing was when something

didn't fit and had to be returned. Does Jesus fit into your life? As for me, I give God thanks and praise for the gift of Jesus to me and to you. That gift is all too often rejected throughout the year in all of our lives. Let us remember the response of Job, "I know that my redeemer lives." Praise be to God that we are loved unconditionally by a loving parent – who even in the middle of our rejection, return, and re-gifting - loves us.
