Dear Friends in Christ.

I hope you all have had a most blessed Easter season. This is the holiest of all seasons. It brings to light what Christ is all about. I say <u>is</u> because He still is, not was. It is my hope and prayer that this will happen soon, and I have reason to believe that this will happen sooner than later. Let us all join together in earnest prayer that God will deliver this for us. Remember my statement that we have a pastor, God just hasn't told us who it is yet. I still believe that. Elim is not alone in this situation. There are at least four vacancies in our area, and they are all struggling as we are. There is a serious shortage of pastors in our entire Synod, and I believe that is probably true for the ELCA in general. Our seminaries are not overflowing with students. This creates a shortage for all churches of our denomination. Let's not lose heart. There is an answer for this somewhere. In the meantime, keep the good faith.

In closing, I must give a big thank you to our wonderful secretary, Gayle. She has been my rock, figuring things out on her own, and helping me with so many things. THANK YOU GAYLE. And to all of you, dear members of the family of God. Keep the faith. It's Friday, but Sunday is a coming.

The love of God and the peace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all.
