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Good wintery days to you, Elim –

These cold, wet stretches have afforded me wonderful hours of study and planning. I hope you have found fulfilling, warm activities as well!

One of the things I've learned and shared in worship is about a first-century fishing boat found by the Sea of Galilee in 1986. Scientific dating techniques place the boat in Jesus' time or shortly thereafter. This boat was mostly built from low-quality materials and held together with wooden plugs and resin, but it was tended to and reused for decades. It might have even been used for a *century*! The boat was obviously made by skilled, resourceful people who had a healthy dose of ingenuity. These were probably pretty darned good qualities for disciples of Jesus!

I've also been reading some of the history of the church and thinking of us today in its lineage. The generations of Elim are filled with do-ers who saw needs and dreamed up ways to meet the needs. As a small, tangible, current example, I've never seen a post coming down from a kitchen ceiling with electrical outlets. Obviously there was more power needed in our upstairs kitchen (probably for the Swedish Supper?) so someone figured out how to make it work! They are useful outlets and I see them being used often! I feel like the cloud of witnesses of Elim and its people still today are skilled, resourceful people who had and have a healthy dose of ingenuity. I love getting to be with you as the church!

As we continue discerning God's call to us collectively and individually into this new year and decade, may we hold on to our tradition which is so dear and think anew as well. You are good at this! I've read of it in the pages of your history and I've seen it in you during these first four months together. You are thoughtful, willing, creative do-ers. You love each other even if you don't agree with each other about everything which is exactly what we are called to do as God's people. I appreciate this very moment with you and look forward to becoming with you as well. Cheers to the strong line of disciples of Christ from which we come and into which we live.

# WELCA NEWS

**WELCA had a busy 2019 year, and we are already off to a good start for 2020.** We hope and pray that more women of WELCA will become involved, and give us ideas and wanted events that would be welcomed by WELCA and stay with the goal of community involvement, church assistance, and international attention. Our first WELCA Board meeting (**which we welcome any person to attend**) was attended by our new Pastor – Amy Kay Pavlovich – and Gayle Nelson, church secretary.

Gayle asked WELCA (and Elim) to become involved with the Christmas Shoebox Project that is organized and led by Fremont Church and their congregation. WELCA voted to do so, and you will get more information about these important “boxes” from Gayle. We can become involved **immediately**, and the list of needed goods will be asked for each month. They will be “assembled” in November 2020, and Elim can assist by helping with the assembly – or just bring donated items each month. This is a year-long project and very worthwhile.

WELCA also showed support for our community and surrounding communities by agreeing to donate \$200 to “Bethlehem Revisited” – an event that those 34 who attended in December 2019 truly enjoyed. They do NOT charge any admission, so the donation will show that Elim hopes the experience will continue in the upcoming December. We also voted to give \$100 each to Ashby House and Rescue Mission in Salina. If there are any other worthy causes you would like to see us donate to, please let one of the officers know and we will consider it at our next meeting. You are even welcomed to come to the meeting and give us your suggestion.

WELCA Executive Board discussed other activities for 2020 with the assistance of our new pastor, Rev. Amy Kay. We will be celebrating WELCA Sunday on **March 22, 2020** with Julie Olson working with Pastor about the “women of influence in religion”. It will be a learning experience for everyone. WELCA will also be doing a **breakfast that morning from 9:30 – 10:55 a.m.** Since many people seemed to enjoy the egg casserole, fruit, cinnamon rolls and juice/coffee at our last breakfast, we will be repeating that on March 22, 2020. **Please mark your calendars to attend WELCA Sunday and breakfast that day.** We will be putting up “volunteer lists” on the bulletin board soon. WELCA has agreed to sponsor a **monthly collection of items** to help fill the Christmas Shoeboxes for 2020. These items are then packed in the designated shoeboxes at a **packing party held at Freemount Lutheran Church in mid-November**. 306 shoeboxes were filled last year at Freemount! 10,569,405 were filled worldwide in 2019. Each box contains items specific to girls and boys of varying ages. We will be listing items needed per month in the bulletin and Messenger. There will also be lists posted on the bulletin board, and a box or basket for the items in the Parish Hall and the back of the sanctuary, starting in February. Please help with this wonderful cause, and join with our fellow Christians in the community by donating items for needy children around the world. THANK YOU!

Here's the list for each month. Underlined items are needed for EVERY box, the remaining items are extras.

**January and February:**

Socks for boys and girls, all sizes

Scarves, stocking caps, gloves or mittens

***For girls:*** small sewing kits, fabric square (Fat Quarters), seam rippers, sewing tape measures, pins, needles, and other sewing supplies

**March:**

***Fun stuff!!*** Small cars, balls, harmonicas, kazoos, yo-yo's, slinky's, small Etch-a-Sketches, jump ropes, noise makers, Legos, puzzles, jacks, small games, dolls, Barbies, Beanie Babies, stuffed animals, BOOKS.

**April:**

Brushes, Toothbrushes and floss

**May:**

T-shirts, sunglasses, ball caps, visors, hairclips, play jewelry, watches, flashlights (with extra batteries), umbrella. Use your imagination for useful items children of all ages can use!

**June:**

Flip-flops, canvas shoes, clothing (shorts, leggings, t-shirts, dresses)

**May:**

***For boys:*** small hammer, nails, rolls of twine, fishing supplies

**August:**

School supplies: pens, pencils, pencil sharpeners, crayons, markers, stamps with ink pads, glue sticks coloring books, solar calculators, rulers, etc.

**October:**

Collect donations for shipping costs (\$9.00 per shoebox)


