#### **NASHVILLE MISSION TRIP**

Bo Bacon, Dawson Feil, Elsie Boughfman, Josh Bocox, Noah Bearley, Raven Caesar, Sebastian Pavlovich, and Carly and Lars Peterson went on a mission trip to Nashville, Tennessee March 12-18. We stayed at McKendree Church in downtown Nashville. This trip was arranged through City Service Mission (CSM), a Christian organization that helps arrange a place to stay and mission work opportunities for groups seeking to serve. Below are the places we served:

- Project Cure (ships medical supplies that would go to waste in the United States to countries in need)- We
  worked in the warehouse sorting and labeling medical supplies.
- Friends of Warner Park- We planted trees in a conservation project to remove invasive species of trees and plant native species.
- Mathew 25 (food bank)- We packed boxes of food for over 60 families.
- Ken and Carols: Community Care Fellowship (homeless shelter)- We welcomed people, prepared and served lunch, and helped them access the services available through the shelter.
- Welcome Home Ministries (organization that provides housing and a support network for those recovering from addiction)- We spread gravel, trimmed trees, painted a shed, and did yard work.
- We planted over 600 trees on a riverbank for soil conservation

We also went on a prayer tour to learn more about Nashville's history and pray for those we saw throughout the city. We packed lunches which we shared with some people who were homeless and prayed with them too. After the trip, we all felt much more comfortable sharing our faith with others. We saved a little time to see the sights which included the Country Music Hall of Fame and seeing a show at the Grand Ole Opry.

As sponsors, we (Carly and Lars) were inspired that the youth chose to use their entire spring break to serve the Lord and grow in their faith. If you want to hear more, be sure to attend our worship service and meal on April 30th for Youth and Senior Sunday!
