A happy new calendar year to you, Elim!

In addition to the first month of 2025, we western Christians get to begin the season of Epiphany. As our stories go, the magi found Jesus on the 12th day of Christmas (December 25 + 12 days = January 6) and we celebrate it in the church on the first Sunday after January 1. I LOVE the season of Epiphany! During this time we think of the Light, thanks be. It is a celebration of the One in whom we know life. It's a delightful time and one that has taken many shapes for Christians around the world.

WELCA NEWS


