Greetings, church -

I hope you are feeling at peace and are enjoying the end of this season of Epiphany!

As our season of Light draws to an end, we look towards the transition to Lent. The season of Lent is a time of introspection and thoughtful preparation before Easter. This year we are again blessed to get to be with our siblings in Christ at Marquette United Methodist Church for a Wednesday night Lenten worship series. Pastor Brenda at MUMC was inspired by a Lutheran Pastor to think of the notion of 'dirt' in our scriptures and lives. I am grateful to once again follow her lead!

Pastor Brenda and I hope that those who are able to come to Wednesday night worship services will connect with God through worship and experience a deepening of faith through the stories that involve the basic element of dirt.

Each Wednesday evening we will gather for worship at 6:30pm.

March 5, Ash Wednesday, we will meet at Elim and Pastor Brenda will preach. We will focus on being created from dust. The sign of the cross will be shared in ash with anyone who would like to participate in the ritual.

March 12 we will meet at MUMC and I will preach. We will focus on the bricks in the story of the tower of Babel.

March 19 we will meet at Elim and Pastor Brenda will preach. We will focus on our clay-ness and God as our Potter.

March 26 we will meet at MUMC and I will preach. Jesus once spit into the dirt to heal. We will focus on this mud.

April 2 we will meet at Elim and Pastor Brenda will preach. There is a story about types of soil. Pastor Brenda will bring it to life for us this evening.

April 9 we will meet at MUMC and I will preach. Jesus spoke about shaking the dust off of our feet at one point. This night we will contemplate how the story informs our lives.

April 17, Maundy Thursday, we will meet at Elim and I will preach. Jesus washed the disciples' feet because they were dirty and this cleansing is what a servant did in Jesus' time. Then they all ate together. They remembered the stories of their ancestors in the Jewish faith and new things started happening. So too will it be for us this evening.

April 18, Good Friday, we will meet at MUMC and worship will be led by Pastor Brenda.

Pastor Brenda and I are excited about this series and the opportunity to lead worship together through this season. We hope you are able to come along with us as we seek to grow in our faith together during our Lenten journey.



going great.


Evangelism/Social Ministry: No meeting.
