A glorious Eastertide to you, Elim -

As a resurrection people, we know this season as life giving. It feels fantastic to get to linger in the goodness! I hope you are able to come to worship this month and experience the joy and hope that comes from the empty cross.

During worship on April 27, we were blessed by the witness of 14 Confirmands as they affirmed the vows of their baptisms. Confirmation is an intentional two-year time when we build on our childhood learning of Bible stories to start forming what we believe as ones growing into adulthood. This group met every other Sunday from 10a - 1:30p. We typically had class before worship, dinner after worship and then a project, or we finished our morning lesson. Confirmation is a big commitment.

Last Sunday the Confirmands were brave to share their personal Statements of Faith in front of all 135 gathered for worship. Each stated what they actually believe right now while understanding that what we believe changes as we learn more and grow. It is important for us all, at every stage of our lives, to think about what we believe and why as disciples of Christ.

It has been a pleasure to get to work with this group. They were open to learning; they seem to have gotten the main things I intended for them to internalize. Many of them were good about reflecting on worship in their bulletins for me. They were willing to jump into projects together; Pageants, a Riverview Party, sacred art and a few days of service were all great experiences with these kids. They were considerate; on the rare occasion they weren't able to make it to class, they almost always let me know beforehand. They were fun. I am proud of each of the kids and am excited to be with them as they continue to become all of who God calls them to be.

I'm grateful for the many who helped with this class. Families supported their Confirmand getting to church. Parents provided Dinner. Adults worked side by side with the kids during God's Work, Our Hands. Brooke facilitated Riverview door decorations our first year together and Monica did so with our party last December. Allan, Jackie, Diane and many others helped with both Pageants. Gayle and Diane took care of many administrative details throughout our two years together. In fact, last Sunday would not have been grand without their leadership with robing, flowers, certificates and gifts. With exceptional hospitality, Nancy, Julie and the entire Adult Bible Study class created a delicious Brunch and beautiful setting for the Confirmands and their families before worship. The day was special. It was a wonderful way to cap an important two-year journey. Thanks be to God for Elim as a whole church and everyone in it who helped it be so.

During worship I was honored to bless each person's confirmation of their baptismal vows. Before I did so, I shared a specific verse of scripture with each new church member. A number of friends were interested in seeing the list so Gayle was kind to make room for it here (see page 2).


